Along with well-trained counselors and program instructors, every camper will have memories and friendships that last a lifetime. **SPACE IS LIMITED!** We have 6 spots reserved for this summer camp, 4 for ages 8-12 years old (2 male and 2 female) and 2 for ages 13-14 (1 male and 1 female). Youth have to be registered through 4-H Online in order to attend. This is a free registration but is mandatory. Spots are first-come first-served. Once the deposit is made, then that spot is filled.
